- Develop 3D models in Sketch-up and/or Revit
- Application of basic elements and principles of design including form, scale, color, texture, pattern, light, balance and proportion
- Participate in site analysis, including survey of existing conditions and field measurements
- Participate in FF+E installations
- · Keep organized and check your work for accuracy, omissions, and legibility
- Organize and manage interiors library including communication with vendors/ reps/manufacturers
- Assist Construction Administration team with review of submittals and shop drawings and RFI responses
- Review of purchase orders from procurement agency and/or furniture dealership
